Environmentally Deice!



Ice build-up on sidewalks and driveways caused by ice storms and melting snow is extremely common this winter. There are many alternatives to using traditional rock salt as a deicer, as rock salt carried by snow and ice melt pollutes our streams and waterways. To help minimize rock salt pollution, consider using more environmentally friendly deicers, such as calcium magnesium acetate, magnesium chloride or non-chloride deicing products.

SNOW AND ICE REMOVAL FROM SIDEWALKS

Residents are reminded to clear a pathway through snow and ice on their sidewalks within twenty-four (24) hours after a snow or ice weather event has ended. The cleared pathway is to be at least thirty (30) inches wide and thoroughly cleaned of snow and ice to facilitate a person's safe passage. The cleared pathway must extend the entire length of the sidewalk, including any handicapped ramps that may be present. Also, note that when clearing sidewalks snow and ice may not be deposited onto streets. Failure to clear the required pathway within 24 hours after a snow or ice weather event has ended and/or depositing the snow or ice onto streets may result in a criminal fine of up to \$1,000 per violation plus the

Township's cost of prosecution. The clearing of sidewalks is required by Ordinance No. 168, which was adopted by the Board of Supervisors on September 13, 2010. A copy of the ordinance can be obtained at the Township Municipal Building or by visiting the Township's website (www.eastcoventry-pa.gov) and reviewing Part 4, Removal of Snow and Ice, Chapter 10 Health and Safety of the Township's Code of Ordinances.
